April 18, 2022

Convene

Presiding Commissioner Steve Daleske called the meeting of the Benton County Commission to order at 9:00 a.m. on April 18, 2022 at the Board Room. Attendance: Larry Berry, Present: Scott Harms, Present: Steve Daleske, Present.

Approval of Prior Minutes

District 2 Commissioner Scott Harms made the motion to approve prior minutes dated 4/11/2022. District 1 Commissioner Larry Berry seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Larry Berry (Yes), Scott Harms (Yes), and Steve Daleske (Yes).

Kaysinger Basin Regional Planning Commission

Commissioners discussed the Kaysinger Basin Regional Planning Commission sub-committees, noting that the Presiding Commissioner is typically the County representative to the Transportation Advisory Committee (TAC). District 2 Commissioner Scott Harms made the motion to re-appoint Presiding Commissioner Steve Daleske to the Transportation Advisory Committee. The Treasurer gave his weekly financial report; the County Clerk submitted bills for approval and payment.

Fuel Bid

District 2 Commissioner Scott Harms made the motion to accept the bid from MFA Oil Company for diesel fuel for Road District #2 at a cost of \$4.226 per gallon. District 1 Commissioner Larry Berry seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Larry Berry (Yes), Scott Harms (Yes), and Steve Daleske (Yes). Other bid was received from Warsaw Oil Company at a cost of \$4.475 per gallon; the County accepted the low bid price.
