July 29, 2019

Convene

Presiding Commissioner Steve Daleske called the meeting of the Benton County Commission to order at 9:00 a.m. on July 29, 2019 at the Board Room. Attendance: David Malecki, Present: Glen Nelson, Present: Steve Daleske, Present.

Approval of Prior Minutes

District 2 Commissioner Glen Nelson made the motion to approve prior minutes dated 7/22/19, District 1 Commissioner David Malecki seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: David Malecki (Yes), Glen Nelson (Yes), and Steve Daleske (Yes).

Motion/Vote - Fuel Bid

District 2 Commissioner Glen Nelson made a motion to approve the bid for Road District #2 for diesel fuel from MFA Oil Company at a cost of \$2.2407 per gallon. David Malecki seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: David Malecki (Yes), Glen Nelson (Yes), Steve Daleske (Yes). Other bid was received from Warsaw Oil Company at a cost of \$2.25 per gallon. The county accepted the low bid price.

Motion/Vote - Conflict of Interest Ordinance

Presiding Commissioner Steve Daleske made a motion to re-adopt the Conflict of Interest Ordinance for Benton County. David Malecki seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: David Malecki (Yes), Glen Nelson (Yes), Steve Daleske (Yes). The ordinance remains the same as originally adopted in 2000, and will be filed with the Missouri Ethics Commission (MEC).

Treasurer and County Clerk Reports

The treasurer gave his weekly financial report; the county clerk submitted bills for approval and payment.

Pleasant Ridge Estates

Citizens from Pleasant Ridge Subdivision met with the commission to discuss the roadways located within this subdivision. Those present included Deborah and Herbert Cobb, Janet Bollinger, Judy and Lloyd Halterman, and Thomas Bollinger. Sheriff Eric Knox was also present. Commissioners advised the group that this is a home owners association issue and outside the jurisdiction of the county commission; the sheriff confirmed this statement and made recommendations to resolve this matter.
